# Project Director K.L.Priya presented recent data from April 2020 to February 2021:

She told Cheyutha received 5 years project from AZIM Premji philanthropic Initiatives. She told focus of the project is on organization development. After completing the 5 years Cheyutha need to sustain on its own in the coming future.

She told Cheyutha works for community development and conduct different kinds of activities for well being of the community members specially focusing on Women and Children

K.L.Priya had explained they have been supporting to the members from 2005 to 2020 with free services but they have not charged any money from the members when it comes for sustainability the board members had decided to collect membership fees from the community members.

If we increase more members, we can fight together for all our rights and which is necessary to the community members

So Women members will be taken as direct members, indirect members will be partners immediately support from the family members, with this membership it is one of the sources for sustainability

**Clinical Support**: Cheyutha members will come to clinic every month on Saturdays as they are given prophylaxis treatment as members take ART medicines from government as they have seasonal health problems and fungal infections, ART side effects. when these members go out for the clinics they have been charged expensive and the medicines are also very costly, Cheyutha conduct clinic and they are provided with free counselling, Doctor consultation and free medicine as such members got benefited Regular members Male 32, Female 100, Male Child 7, Female child 5 Total-144.

New Registration: Male 16, Female 30, Male Child 3, Female child 2 Total-51 members,

Follow ups: Male 153, Female 503, male child 49, Female Child 24 Total-729 members,

**On Art treatment:** Male 46, Female 129, Male child 10, Female child 7 Total-192.

Cd4 countdown: Male 22, Female 34, Male child 4, Female child 2, Total-62 members.

On TB treatment: Male 5, Female 5, Total-10 member.PCR test Male child 4, Female Child 2, total 6 children.

**Education support for children**: A Cheyutha mainly focus on the education and specially on girls education most of the children who come from complete orphan and semi orphan families are been given education support, Cheyutha strongly believes education is basic right of every child when it comes to HIV children mostly if they tell about their status in schools and colleges they face stigma and discrimination and most of the children they are unable to pay the fees, So Cheyutha had got education support from Azim Premji and Mrs.Usha Gummala, Change foundation and Local Donors, So this year we could able to support 33 students. The hard work of the students the results we get it is not less than 95%.They pass with the flying colors. Who have taken support form Cheyutha and now they are able to lead their life on their own without depending on anyone.

<u>Nutrition support for children and women</u>: Cheyutha provides nutrition support for foster care children on monthly basis and supported by Value Labs.

**Support group members**: As the nutrition is very important for HIV members because they will take ART Medication on daily basis and they need food to increase their CD4 count on monthly basis they have given ½ Kg peanuts, ½ Kg til, 1 Kg Jaggery supported by APPI.

**APPI:** Has come forward to help community members with groceries and sanitary napkins for women and Girl Children by giving financial aid of Rs.5, 54,950/- which helped 233 members in COID-19 pandemic

An ADP Private Limited yearly support twice for dry ration and this year in Covid time we got additional support from APPI in drastic situation as HIV community members have lost their daily wages and their small jobs which leaded them with no food provided in-kind support groceries 151 members got benefited which was very helpful in this Covid period.

<u>Meeting at ART Centers</u>: Cheyutha Outreach workers will conduct meeting at ART centers on different aspect to the members like counselling, medical adherence, about social schemes etc and the services provided at Cheyutha and they referred cases if they have any emergency health problems and enrolled them in the Cheyutha for further support Male 161, Female 387, Total 548 members

**Emergency support for medical need**: Cheyutha always extends its support for any medical emergency for its members. Members who need emergency support for blood transmission, admission in care and support centre or required any surgeries they have approached Cheyutha and Cheyutha had been referred them according to their health problems to the service providers, Such cases like Male 59,Female 145 Total members got benefited 204.

**Support Group Meetings:** We have support group members who meet monthly once and save Rs.100/- to Rs.200/- in the bank which from ART pension and Widow Pension. All these members have been trained on how to deal with financial; Education for their children and low cost nutrition and trained them as a positive speaker As such 60 members have been enrolled as members

**Positive marriage:** Marriage is right of each and every individual; Cheyutha came forward to conduct positive marriages for the community members. Team will arrange meeting for the members who wants to marry. They will show different profiles of members and encourage them for positive marriages. Every year Cheyutha will facilitate 5 to 6 marriages but due to Covid this year they could only facilitate 1 positive marriage which helps them also prevent HIV no infections in new born babies.

**Legal services:** With the help of legal service authorities Cheyutha forwards Legal cases of the women to district legal services authorities, which includes right for property, divorce case etc. Total 9 cases are been followed up in the court.

**Drop in Centers:** Members who have been referred from ICTC centers and ART centers to Cheyutha services and these members have been counseled at the centre and do the needful. As such cases Male 95, Female 139, Total 234 members have availed the services.

**Events conducted:** Education support, World AIDS Day, Conducted awareness programme on legal service authority.

Project Director invited the entire positive speaker to speak few words about their experience with Cheyutha

**Niharika:** Niharika wished all the member and chief guest. She told she came to Cheyutha at the age of 7 years. She told received nutrition support, education support and clinical support from Cheyutha from the age of 7 years. Her parents are died because of HIV/AIDS and form then she was taken care by her grandparents, she thanked them for their support. She explained the struggle she faced in the life and told education played important role in her life. Along with the education she advised all the children should who are living with HIV should take care of their health and take the medication without fail. She thanked Dr.Rao Sir, Dr.Aruna madam Medical officer and Priya and Cheyutha team for the support given to her. She told she is working for an MNC company and taking care of her grandparents. And also did her part by contribution small donation to Cheyutha.

**<u>Rekha</u>:** Rekha is daughter of Shanthamma member of Cheyutha. She told father expired with HIV/AIDS in 2016 and from then her mother is availing clinical services and nutrition support with Cheyutha. She told her mother never used to take ART medication properly and during lock down period she became very weak with opportunity deceases. She told no hospital admitted her in Covid period. She told they approached Cheyutha team for the support. Then Shanthamma referred to Shivanandha Hospital by Cheyutha team. They spent 15 days in hospital until she recovered. Then according to her health condition she referred to Dr.Dinakar private

doctor who will treat HIV patients. After taking the treatment now her health is recovered and taking ART second line medication properly, she then also supported by Cheyutha to start her second line treatment in Gandhi Hospital. Rekha thanked Cheyutha for support them in the lock down period.

Ayesha Sana: Ayesha Sana member of Cheyutha lost her husband 8 years ago and faced stigma and discrimination from her in-laws family. She approached other NGOS who are working on HIV/AIDS and her case was not solved and did not get any support form in-laws and then she was referred by Cheyutha member Sarojini. When she approached Cheyutha she explained about her situation and she told not getting any support from the in-law. Cheyutha team referred her case to district legal services Shri K.Murali Mohan Garu Secretary cum Senior Civil Judge City Civil Court- Hyderabad Legal services Authority had supported within short span of time she own the case. In law agreed to give her 16.5 lakhs amount for her. She thanked Cheyutha team and Priya madam for supporting her in legal case.

# Distribution of SCR Loans:

Cheyutha initiated started in 8<sup>th</sup> March 2017 and support the women members by providing SCR loan and which able those to start their petty businesses which help them to take care of their families and the members will be repaying the amount monthly. First two years who have taken the SCR loans have paid properly but from 2019 and 2020 members who have taken the loan have not paid their loan due to Covid situation and no business for them they have asked for time. This year we have mobilized funds for the SCR loan and identified members who need support, and the cheques had been distributed by the chief guest and other guest of honor to the below members to start their businesses.

- K.Laxmi : SCR loan was given to purchase push cart (topudubandi) to sell vegetables with Rs. 10,000 Cheque
